The healthcare supply chain: a growth driver for the country

The 62nd AFI Symposium entitled “The healthcare supply chain: a growth driver for the country” will take place as usual at the Palacongressi of Rimini (Italy) from 7th to 9th June 2023.

The healthcare supply chain is a strategic sector for the Italian economy and can generate added value and employment as well as ensure the health and well-being of the population. It is a complex system involving a range of activities, from the development and production of pharmaceutical products and medical devices to scientific research and development as well as the distribution and marketing of health products and services. It is, moreover, a highly innovative and competitive sector, where the capacity to invest in research and development, rooted in a solid scientific and technological base, plays a fundamental role.

Nevertheless, this industry will have to face major challenges and opportunities in the near future, starting from the increasing demand for health products and services, linked especially to the aging population, with all that this entails.

Furthermore, while the evolution of digital technologies and molecular biology enables the development of new products and customized therapies, it also requires greater interaction between the different scientific disciplines and a strong capacity for innovation.

For this reason, it is fundamental that the healthcare supply chain should continue to invest in research and development, promoting collaboration between companies, universities, research centres, and public institutions, promoting the training of young talents, the creation of innovation networks and the dissemination of best practices nationally and internationally.

Lastly, but no less important, the healthcare supply chain represents an opportunity to promote sustainable development and environmental protection via the adoption of more efficient and environmental-friendly technologies and processes. In this way, this industry can become a virtuous model of economic, social, and environmental development for the entire country.

This is the context for the 2023 AFI Symposium.

The Symposium will include multiple sessions, with the presence of authoritative speakers from the Industry, the Universities, the Agenzia Italiana del Farmaco (AIFA), the Ministry of Health, the Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS), and the Trade Associations.

The outstanding novelty of this 62nd Symposium

is its new layout, which is intended to provide visitors with a more modern, dynamic, and customized experience.

There will also be a New Event Area inside the Exhibition Area.

In addition to this new exhibition layout, there will also be an extension of the Meeting Rooms, which are three this year.

The Symposium will begin with a speech by the AFI President, Giorgio Bruno, to be followed by the **Keynote Lecture** held by the President of Farmindustria, Marcello Cattani, who will focus on the theme of the Symposium. **Thirteen scientific sessions** will follow, dedicated to areas of particular interest.

The **Biotech** will discuss the evolution in advanced therapies using pharmaceutical products that are more effective, safer, and more accessible to patients, while that dedicated to the session dedicated to **Supply Chain and Innovation** will focus on innovative processes and technologies for patient support. These will be followed on Thursday by sessions on **Quality and Manufacturing**, with a presentation on contamination control and containment in pharmaceutical production, and on **Clinical Trials**, with a focus on a very topical issue such as the impact of privacy, cybersecurity, and new regulations on research. Of great interest, as always, will be the sessions on **HTA/Regulatory Affairs/Pharmacovigilance**, **APIs**, and **Pharmaceutical Sciences**, which this year will address the impact of Pharmaceutical Technology on the treatment of respiratory disorders.

The **AFI CRS ADRITELF**, instead, will be dedicated to the presentation of some new production technologies (electrospinning, microfluidics, 3D printing). The day will end with the session on the **Youth Generation, a commitment to the future** in collaboration with Farmaceutica Younger.

Friday will include sessions on **Medical Devices**, **Food Supplements**, **Biocides**, and **European Regulations**, which have always been key for those attending the Symposium.

There will also be **7 Corporate Workshop** in a session dedicated to individual companies with updates on the latest breakthroughs and innovations, the **Women-in-Pharma Forum**, a panel discussion dedicated to the women in the pharma-biotech industry, and the **Start-up Forum**, dedicated to start-ups in the pharma, biotech, medical and diagnostic device industry.

Lastly, a **Poster** session will allow researchers to illustrate the results of their activities.
