## The main challenges for the Healthcare Industry: Research, Innovation, Sustainability

#### The 63<sup>th</sup> AFI Symposium on "The main challenges for the Healthcare Industry: Research, Innovation and Sustainability" will take place as usual at the Palacongressi of Rimini from 5th to 7th June 2024.

The Healthcare Industry is a crucial cornerstone of the Italian economy and aims to ensure the health and well-being of the population, while generating added value and jobs. This is an interdisciplinary, complex, and dynamic economic sector with a wide range of activities, such as research, development, production of medicines and medical devices. clinical trials. distribution. and marketing. From a business perspective, it is a very competitive sector, where innovation, built on sound scientific and technological bases. plays an essential role, as does the ability to sustain medium-long term investments. From a social and professional point of view, this sector offers equal opportunities to both men and women in all job roles, including top-management positions.

In this pivotal moment marked by the rise of artificial intelligence technologies and digital therapies, the healthcare sector will have to face numerous new challenges and opportunities in the near future. Besides the increasing demand for healthcare products and services, driven by an ageing population, we are faced with a growing need to integrate diverse scientific disciplines and foster a robust innovation culture, thus seizing this opportunity to contribute to sustainable development and environmental protection. The adoption of more efficient and environment-friendly technologies and production processes can significantly help this sector become more environmentally sustainable. Not only does this approach fulfil current needs, but can also become a reference framework for the benefit of all.

It is therefore essential that we continue to invest in research and development, encouraging collaboration between companies, universities, research centres and public institutions. Such efforts will not only create new talents, but also foster new innovation networks and the dissemination of best practices on both national and international scales. This is the context in which the 63th AFI Symposium will take place with 19 Scientific Sessions, 2 Keynote Lectures (Dr. Marcello Cattani, Sen. Elena Cattaneo) and many satellite events featuring eminent speakers from the industry, universities institutions and trade associations.

The Symposium will begin on Wednesday afternoon with a speech by the AFI President, Giorgio Bruno, to be followed by the Keynote Lecture held by the President of Farmindustria, Marcello Cattani, who will focus on the main topic discussed this year. This opening session will be followed by the scientific sessions, focusing on areas of significant interest. The Energy and Sustainability session will delve into the diverse facets of sustainability as applied to the pharmaceutical sector. The following sessions will be devoted to the Supply Chain, Packaging Materials and Digital Health, while the closing session on Startups aims to promote a culture that recognizes and promotes innovative ideas across this sector from research labs to market access.

On Thursday the morning session will start with the **Keynote Lecture** "There is no care without research" held by Sen. Elena Cattaneo. The next sessions will be on **Clinical Research**, focusing on "Innovation and Sustainability", **Quality**, **HTA**, and **Deblistering**, ending with the **Piazza delle Donne**.

The afternoon sessions will be on **Environmental Risk Assessment** focusing on the conventional approach and the prospects related to the new European directive, **AFI-SITELF** Pharmaceutical Sciences, Biotech, Pharmacovigilance, Medical Devices, Advertising and Medical and Scientific Information in the Era of Digital Technologies and CRF-SITELF.

Friday will start with a session on **Parenterals** and continue with a session on **Innovation** focused on Artificial Intelligence, Process Digitalization and 4.0 GAMP 5 Validation and Qualification 2nd edition. The Symposium will end with the sessions on **APIs** and **Specialty Products**.

As usual, the **Poster** session will allow participants to showcase the results of their projects.
